BUCCANEER POOLS

Welshpool, Western Australia

Design objective: Meet the clients' desire for a tropical installation that fits into a relatively narrow space.

Pool facts: The modified Roman shape and azure blue shell provide the coastal look the setting needed. Full-length stairs grace the shallow end, while a swim-out helps with egress from the deep end.

Materials: Reconstituted limestone deck and coping are accented with a black pebble inlay to match the waterfeature.

Added features: A sheet waterfall spills out of a block basin accented with blue tiles set on the diagonal. A black-stone statue in the waterfeature and the various palms bookending it add to the indigenous feel. A thatched-roof gazebo houses an outdoor bar.
